New Richmond Middle School Completion

Derrick Commercial Contracting completed the year-long, \$8.6 million conversion of New Richmond's old high school to the new middle school this past summer, in time for the 2011-2012 school year. This major renovation project for the School



District of New Richmond involved the expansion and remodel of the cafeteria, kitchen, restrooms and administration areas. The scope of work included new ceilings, doors, floor coverings and technology upgrades, new HVAC and lighting systems, as well as replacement of the windows.

At a time when work was scarce, this was a welcomed project for us and the local subcontractors that worked on this job. We thank the New Richmond School District for their trust and confidence in our firm to deliver this

important project on schedule and in a very cost-effective manner.

The project also includes the remodel of approximately 12,500 square feet of the existing structure. Architectural services were provided by BDH & Young Space Design of Edina, Minn. We are currently on schedule for a mid-December completion.
